



Template Installation and Setup Guide for Blocs

1. Install Fonts in Blocs

- Fonts Folder: Open the Fonts folder from the extracted ZIP file.
- Installing Fonts in Blocs:
 - Open Blocs and go to the "Settings" menu.
 - Select the "Fonts" section and click on "Add Fonts".
 - Choose the font files (e.g., .otf or .ttf) from the Fonts folder and add them to Blocs.
- Important Note: Fonts must be added directly in Blocs, not installed on the Mac system.

2. Close Blocs and Open Project

- After adding the fonts in Blocs, close Blocs and reopen it to ensure that the program recognizes the new fonts.

3. Open the Project with .bloccs File or Use .bex Template

- If you received a .bloccs file:
 - Double-click on the .bloccs file from the extracted folder. The project will open in Blocs, and you can start working right away.
- If you received a .bex file (Site Template):
 - Double-click on the .bex file. This file will be added to the "Site Templates" section in Blocs.
 - When starting a new project in Blocs, you can select the template from Site Templates to begin working.

4. Images in the Template

- Images are already included in the template: Most images are already in the template and should appear once you open the project in Blocs.
- If any errors occur:
 - If Blocs has trouble with the images, save the entire Images folder (the img folder) on your Mac.
 - Then, go to Blocs and re-link the images to the project by selecting the folder and re-importing the media.

5. Customize the Template

- Make adjustments: You can now customize the template in Blocs to suit your needs.
- Save: Regularly save your project to ensure that changes are preserved.

6. Export and Publish

- Export: Once you're happy with the design, you can export the project and upload it to your web server. Select "Export" from the menu and follow the instructions.

With these steps, you should be able to easily install and use the template.
